

Dereel Hall Upgrade

The upgrade to the Dereel Hall will be commencing on Monday 30 November.

The project includes-

1. Hall

- Painting of internal walls, ceiling, window architraves and eaves
- Installation of performance lighting and circulation fans
- Acoustic analysis and treatment to ceiling and walls
- Beautification of the entrance foyer
- Internal access to the stage arena

2. Kitchen/Communal Area

- Construction of a new kitchen area and storage area
- Construction of a new communal area- dining/luncheon area
- Meeting room
- Internal disabled and separate unisex toilet

3. Construction of an external public toilet

The following works have been programmed to completed by Christmas

- Demolition of existing communal and kitchen area
- Slab for new footprint of extension
- Slab for new toilet block
- Removal of existing septic system
- Installation and operation of new septic system
- Construction of new public toilet – (this will be dependent upon previously stated works be completed with minimal issues). The new public toilet has been programmed to be completed and available for use no later than January 31, 2016.

During the construction period, all programs will operate from the community centre. Council will be providing temporary toilet facilities, including one toilet for people with a disability, for use by the community until the new toilet block is completed.

Equipment in the kitchen and storage areas has been packed up by members of the community and will be stored in the hall and community centre.

Thank you for your support in dealing with the inconvenience whilst the hall and kitchen area is upgraded. Further programming information will be provided in January.
